EMAIL TO SUSAN HOFFMAN, EDITOR OF THE ARCADIAN, REGARDING SALARY OF ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT BRITTON

Through a public records' request, I received the salary information for the assistant superintendent. The following is a summary of the last two years:

- 2013.2014: the assistant superintendent started the year with a salary of \$71,087.59. When the new salary schedule was approved by the school board, her salary was adjusted with retro pay to \$91,521.62. **This represents an increase of over 28% in salary from the beginning to the end 2013.2014 school year.**
- 2014.2015: the assistant superintendent started the year with a salary of approximately \$97,959.00. **This represents an increase of over 7% of the ending salary for 2013.2014.** This is a wonderful increase before any negotiated increases for the 2014.2015 school year.

These generous salary increases do not correlate with what the teachers and support staff receive. This type of salary increase would certainly offset the necessity of having our athletes' families pay to participate in the athletic program. In addition, I do not feel that this type of singular pay increase will improve our academic performance.
